RATE A RATIO WHERE THE NUMERATOR
AND DENOMINATOR HAVE
DIFFERENT UNITS:

EX) $\frac{\text{miles}}{\text{hours}}$, $\frac{\text{dollars}}{\text{year}}$, etc

When the X values and y values have
different units, then slope will
have units but they will be
different in the top and bottom.
