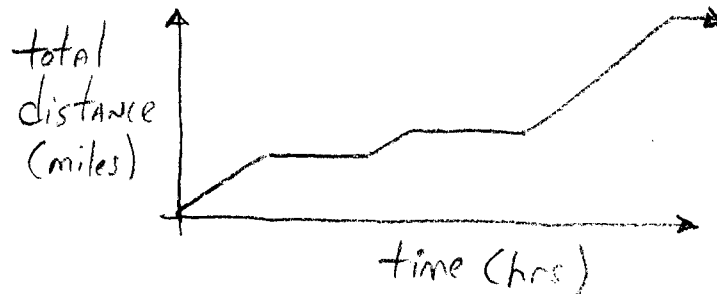
- ① In the following relation, identify the domain, range, independent variable and dependent variable. Then graph the relation.
