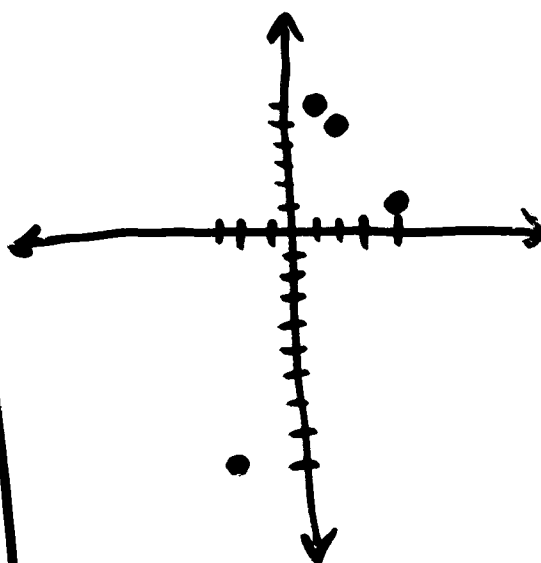
Common ways to show a relation:

List: $\{(1, 6), (2, 5), (-3, -9), (4, 1)\}$

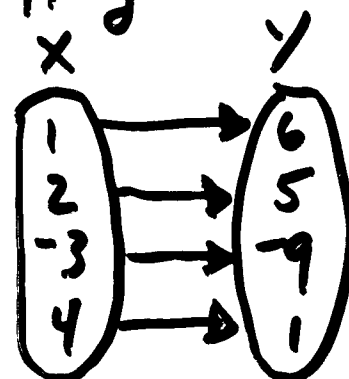
Table:

 swap all of the x's and y's

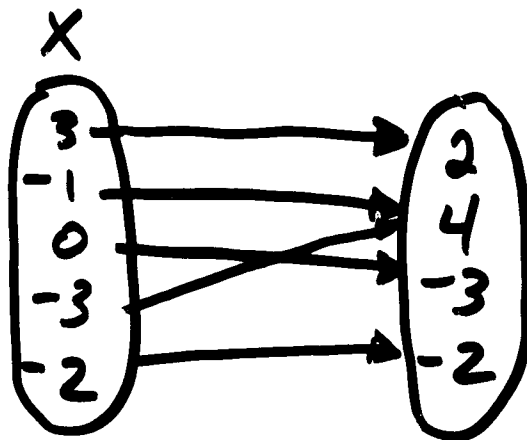
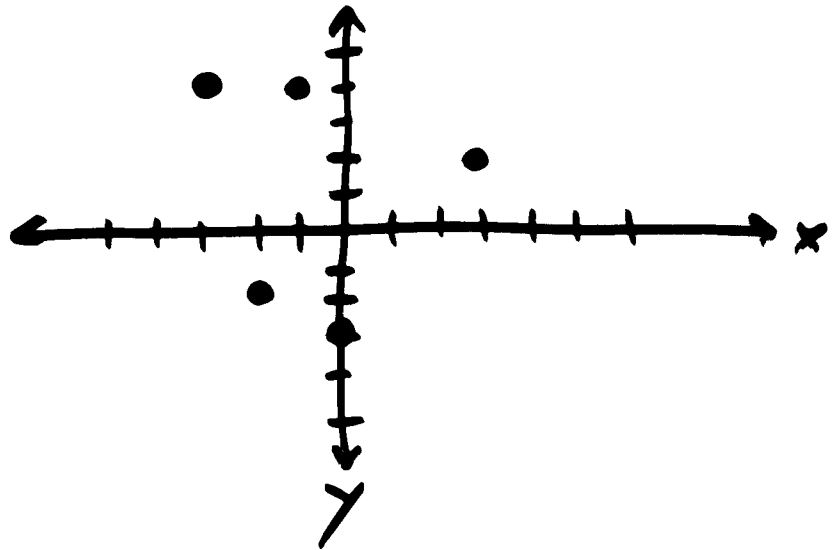
