$$\begin{array}{r} 7 + 3x \leq 4x + 8 \\ -3x \quad -3x \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 7 \leq x + 8 \\ -8 \quad -8 \end{array}$$

$$-1 \leq x$$

$$\therefore \boxed{x \geq -1}$$
